- Applications will be accepted the Friday preceding Thanksgiving and the Friday preceding Valentine's Day each year. Each application will be reviewed by the OECTA Waterloo Unit Human Rights Committee.
- The amount available for funding requests will be determined by the OECTA Waterloo Unit Human Rights Committee based on the number of applications, the nature of the application, and the money available each year.
- The funding available is intended to supplement or start social justice and human rights projects. The available funds are not intended to replace existing funding.
- Funding for projects in any given year does not guarantee funding for projects in future years.
- The Human Rights Committee requires a written report within 30 days of the completion of the project explaining the success of the project and any interesting stories associated with the project. These may be published in unit and provincial publications.
